# 。一〇、校長的話。

# 澳遊新體驗

好在在這四日三夜的旅行中,澳門向我揭開了那層神秘的面 紗,令我對澳門有了另一番不同的感悟。

在旅遊塔上,我站在澳門的最高點鳥瞰整個澳門。儘管遠處的城市被灰濛濛的天色吞噬,但目所能及的世界裏,澳門馬路四通八達,作為城市的動脈連接著橫琴和氹仔等地,上面的車輛不停來往駛過,留下的廢氣在空中翻了個身,然後逐漸消失在空氣中。四圍的樓房圍著馬路建起,卻沒有任何一座會"異軍突起",幾乎所有的樓房都差不多高度,也很少影響到旅遊塔上遊客的視野。這就是澳門啊!站在塔上,四圍吹著呼呼作響的烈風,我突然有種眾人皆醉我獨醒的感覺。澳門作為賭城,在這片小小的土地上,每日都有十幾億上下的交易,人們為賭而瘋狂,而傾家蕩產。我卻像一個世外看客躲在塔上偷得浮生半日閑,沉浸在享受風景的時刻。

參觀大三巴牌坊當天,陽光正好燦爛,高高矗起的大三巴牌坊盡入眼底。原來大三巴牌坊是聖保祿教堂前壁遺址,不但經常出現在風景明信片,更是旅客必遊的澳門八景之一「東方梵蒂岡」。西方巴洛克式的建築,配以東方色彩雕刻,如牡丹和菊花圖案,乃融合中西文化特色的天主教堂。究竟百多年前在同一地

點發生過甚麼事呢?為什麼這教堂僅留下前壁和地基呢?一邊仰望壁上精緻的浮雕,一邊聽着導遊的講解,相信每層浮雕都蘊藏它的故事。作為西方式建築,它的「鄰居」卻是一座中式廟宇——哪吒廟。這兩座建築如此詼諧的存在了幾百年,遊走在兩者之間,我似乎穿越時空,看到了澳門被侵佔的歷史,看到了澳門人在葡國統治下艱辛的日子和樂觀的生活態度。其實這兩所建築不但是歷史的見證,更是在澳門這小小的土地上擦出了火花。

在鄭家大屋,作為傳統中式老宅,佔地甚廣,以它獨有的歷史背景植根在澳門的土地上。院子裏青磚鋪地,柳樹成蔭,一陣古韻古風的氣息撲面而來。我站在大院中,看著院外的風景。遠處的玻璃反射著刺眼的光芒,鋪滿由鋼鐵築成的現代化建築,與這座古老殘舊的大院如此格格不入。在這種古代與現代的碰撞下,我想象著古人在院裡乘涼喝茶的情景與都市人在咖啡店里享受著冷氣悠閒度過的下午,時間似乎在這一刻凝結,兩個場景在澳門的土地上漸漸重疊在了一起。

澳門這個賭城,由於每年的龐大稅收,讓政府得以在保育上面投放了大量資源,歷史建築群幸得保留,吸引旅客觀光的同時,也樣我們這一輩的學生有機會實地考察,加深對當地歷史文化認識。希望香港政府考慮地區發展時,也會顧及古蹟保育,使香港別具特色的建築,如車公廟、甘棠第、鰂魚涌林邊屋、中西區警署古蹟群等得到持之以恆的保育! 6B 孫嘉莉





### A Night in the School Library

Dear Mr. Chan,

Something terrible happened to Danny last night and it shocked me when I came to know this by his text message sent by his mobile phone to me. However, I helped him to deal with the issue eventually and he is ok right now. I am going to tell you what we went through last night.

Actually, Danny was locked in the school library, trapped in the cold, silent and scary darkness and it made him feel helpless and afraid. He went to the library to select some useful books for his History SBA after school. However, various tests, dictations and homework wore him out. With the warmth and silence in the school library, he felt sleepy and lied on the bookshelf in the corner and fell asleep quickly. It might be so relaxing and comfortable for him that he hadn't heard any other sounds and had not known the door was closed! He recognized nothing and nobody found him sleeping in the back of the library. He woke up after dawn, realizing that he was trapped in the school library in the dark alone, and there was no one near the library (It was confirmed by him having shouted for several times). The he turned to ask somebody outside for help with his phone---he sent a text message to me.

I was doing my homework at home when I received his message. Honestly, it was nothing in my first thought. But when I realized, I dressed up immediately and went back to school hurriedly to rescue him. The school gate was closed, so I knocked and the security guard opened it for me. Then I went inside the school and asked a janitor for help after explaining to him. Later, we reached the library and unlocked the door. When I opened it, I saw nothing but scary darkness. Turning on the flashlight from home and calling Danny's name, I could see him walking to me, his tears rolling in his eyes (maybe because of joy and surprise after suffering in darkness and loneliness for hours). His voice was trembling, "Thank God! Someone finally gets me out before the next day! Saving me from the world which makes me terrified and lonely. Thank you"

He seemed really afraid, so I asked him whether he felt sick or hurt. I took him to McDonald's for supper as he strongly wanted to eat burgers against hunger. We had a good and comfortable time and I walked him home. He called me later and said his parents felt relieved when he got home. He sounded ok, at least better than that when I found him in the library. What a relief!

It's fortunate to get him out in a short time. But I suggest that janitors or librarians should check if there's someone still in the library before they cut off the power and lock the door to avoid any accidents like this in future.

### 人無信不立
